- **Project Designation** This scholarship awards an individual up to \$1,000 towards earning the CAE, CMP or other industry related designation.
- Rising Star This scholarship awards an individual who has been in the association profession five years or less, up to \$1,000 and can be used for any association management related professional development program.
- Operation Annual Meeting In order to encourage professional development, this scholarship provides one association professional with key expenses to the 2018 AENC Annual Meeting.
- Raleigh Dingman This scholarship awards \$1,500 to be used towards tuition for the first year at the Institute for Organization Management, administered by the US Chamber of Commerce.
- Mary K. Doherty Scholarship (AENC Professional Development Scholarship) -This scholarship awards up to \$1,000 to be used towards industry related professional development.
- *NEW* AENC FUEL Young Professionals This scholarship awards up to \$1,000 to help advance an individual in Association Management by assisting with costs associated with either an AENC event or Professional Development. Any individual under the age of 40 who is a member in good standing with AENC may apply. FUEL participants are encouraged to apply but FUEL participation is not a requirement to win the scholarship.
